The pictogram set is inserted internally and attached without solvents.

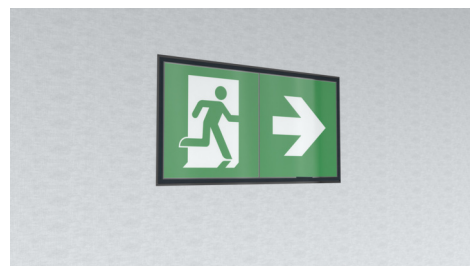
Suitable accessories are available for installation in concrete or masonry:

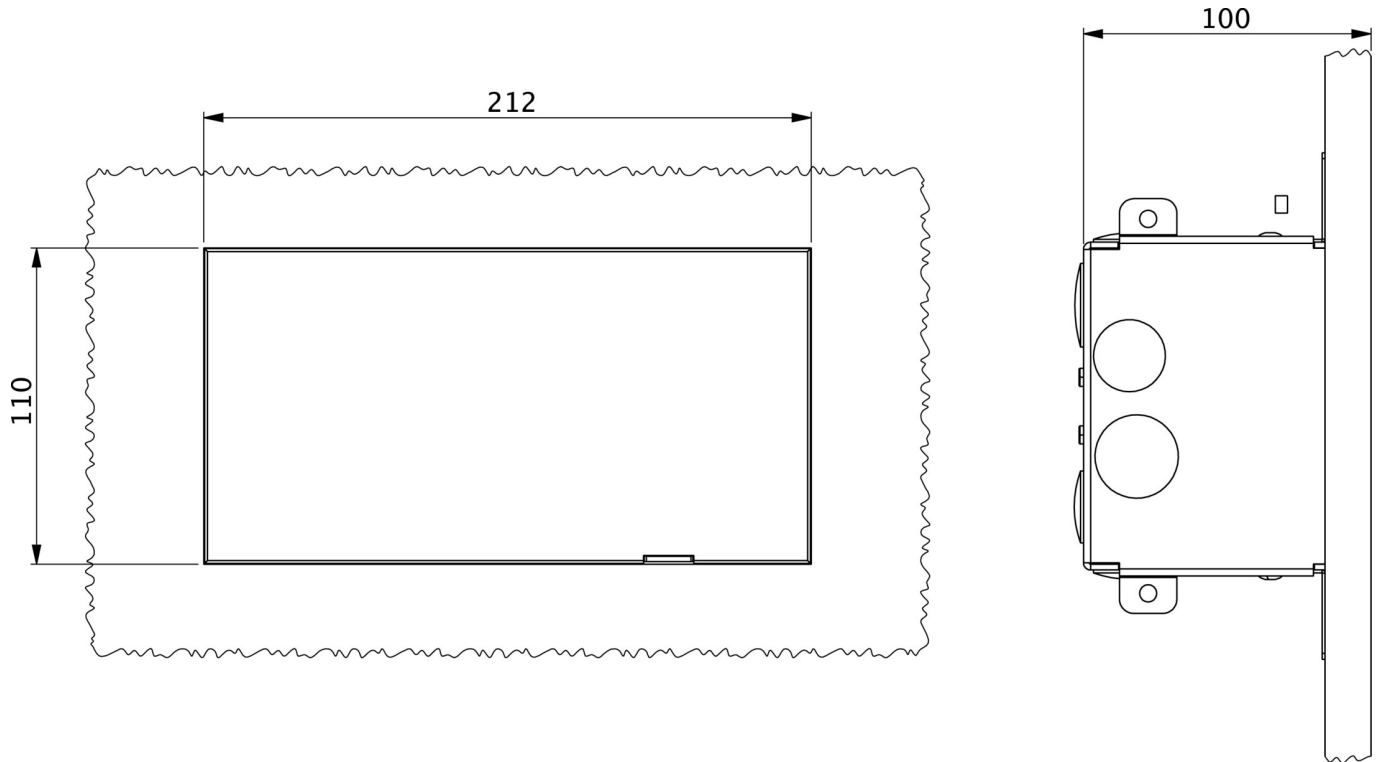
